

Community Center Survey Results

This package contains the results of the Survey on establishing a Community Center. The survey was distributed in the November Town Crier.

113 surveys were returned on time and 5 more came in on November 29th and 30th. 2033 surveys were mailed out, for a 5.8% response rate. The survey cost \$600 to print.

Less money could be better used by modifying existing structures and/or paying for use of other facilities i.e., administrative, guard, janitors, damage bond, etc., bussing. MNCPPC and the Md. Dept. of Education should be lobbied to make better use of their facilities. These include the (1) building in Anacostia River Park near the picnic/ playground and (2) Riverdale Elem. School.
